Unemployment Rate

3.7%

(No change since October 2022)

Total non-farm payroll employment increased by 263,000 in November, and the unemployment rate was unchanged at 3.7 percent. Notable job gains occurred in leisure and hospitality, health care, and government. Employment declined in retail trade and in transportation and warehousing. Among the unemployed, the number of permanent job losers rose by 127,000 to 1.4 million in November. The number of persons on temporary layoff changed little at 803,000.

- Average job growth: 82,000 per month
- Employment: Below its pre-pandemic February 2020 level by 980,000

Manufacturing **+14,000**

- Average job growth: averaged 34,000 per month
- Average workweek: Decreased by 0.2 hour to 40.2 hours

Financial Activities **+14,000**

- Real estate and rental and leasing: +13,000
- Commodity contracts, and investments: +6,000
- Employment growth: 12,000 per month

Construction **+2,000**

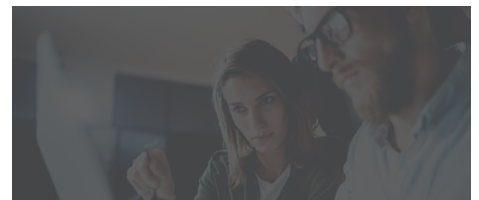
- Non-residential building: +8,000
- Average job growth: 19,000 per month

Information Technology **+19,000**

- Average job growth: 14,000 per month

Other Services **+19,000**

- Personal and laundry services: +11,000
- Social assistance: +23,000
