Total non-farm payroll employment increased by **187,000** in August, and the unemployment rate rose to **3.8 percent**. Employment continued to trend up in health care, leisure and hospitality, social assistance, and construction. Employment in transportation and warehousing declined. The number of unemployed persons increased by **514,000 to 6.4 million**. Both measures are little different from a year earlier, when the unemployment rate was **3.7 percent** and the number of unemployed persons was **6.0 million**.

In August, the labor force participation rate rose by **0.2 percentage** point to **62.8 percent**, after being flat since March. The employment-population ratio was unchanged over the month at **60.4 percent**.
